ARTIFICIAL TURF

The range of artificial turfs that are available now provide an alternative to almost all applications where natural grass has previously been used. The range covered in this leaflet embodies Football, Rugby, Tennis, Swimming pool surrounds, Utility sports areas, Gardens, Roof top restaurants, Training areas and a multitude of other applications.



The Football and Rugby 3G pitches are usually 60/70mm turf pile with a rubber backing laid on a level prepared surface of hardcore and sand. The surface is filled with sand and fine rubber crumb (0.5-1.5mm) to ensure a natural feel and sufficient resilience to prevent injury or friction burns. A contractor usually lays these installations.

Golf Tees. The Tee Turf with 60mm pile is easily laid by the Green staff, or by a contractor if they have not got the time. It is used on practice areas and winter tees



to eliminate a lot of the maintenance work associated with these areas. Put onto a hardcore base either sunk into the ground or with a suitable raised edging. The fill of sand and fine rubber crumb ensures you can strike off the surface or use a tee peg.

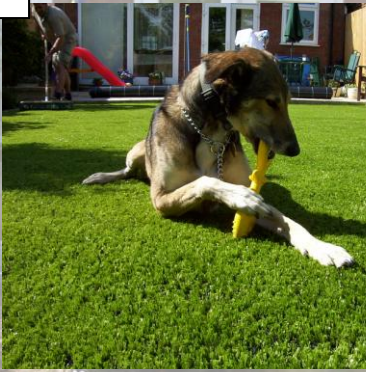
In nearly all situations you have the option of buying the turf and laying it yourself or calling on our contracting services to lay it for you. Where ground works need to be carried out, in preparation for laying the turf, we can organise that as part of the contract.



Pathways - The Path Turf is 20mm and filled with sand and rubber crumb, which will give a quiet path for golfers and prevents it freezing in winter or going hard with long term use. These can be laid

on a hardcore base by your own staff. It is useful to have an edging, the turf being held in position with galvanized nails.





Garden Turf Top 1 This 40mm pile polyethylene/ blend is soft to the feel and can be used either with or without the sand/rubber in fill. If fill is used this pile will lock it into the surface so that it does not tread into in doors. Suitable for animals, can be cleaned and disinfected easily.



Garden Turf Top 2 is a 24mm pile, which is a lower cost alternative to Top turf 1. It requires to be filled with sand/rubber crumb it ensures the pile stands erect and can be employed in all Garden and play area applications.



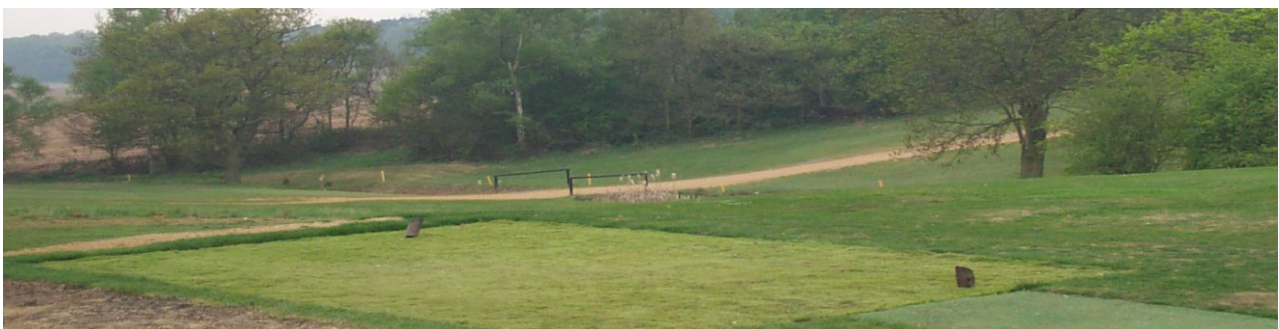
Garden Turf Top 3 is a 12mm curl pile, tightly woven and is used without fill on lawns and swimming pool surrounds, patios, roof top areas, out door restaurants, etc. (photo of swimming pool surround)

Garden Turf Top 4 is 7mm lower cost alternative for providing a green soft cover for any indoors or out door application. (photo)



Tennis courts this is a close pile usually filled with sand to allow true ball bounce. The type of surface can vary dependent on the standard of tennis to be played. The professional surface is considerably different to the surface on which club tennis is played. This can only be decided by discussion prior to a quotation buying provided. The installations are nearly always contractor laid on a true prepared surface.

Hockey pitches are usually close pile, filled with sand to allow true ball run. The installation is nearly always contractor laid on a true prepared surface.
