## **Tee Turf**

### **Artificial Grass All Weather Surface**

The advantages of this system can be summaries as follows:

- **Does not Compact**
- **Holds a tee peg**
- **Any size or shape**
- **Good surface grip**
- **Suitable for studs**
- **Economically priced**
- **Shots can be played directly from the surface.**

This system can be installed permanently, removing the necessity for temporary tee mats. It is easy and quick to install with its 60mm pile filled with a mixture of sand and rubber crumb.

### **Installation guidelines.**

1. **Mark out the area to be used allowing for 4m roll width.**
2. **Excavate to 160mm depth, leaving a smooth finish**
3. **Add 75mm of road planning or hard core, MOT Type 1 is suitable.**
4. **Cover the surface with 25mm of sharp sand or limestone.**
5. **If an edging is required install at this stage.**
6. **Cut Tee Turf to the required size and lay loose into the area.**
7. **If jointing is required use the jointing tape with either hot melt or Polyurethane adhesive.**
8. **Brush the pile upright before lightly filling with sand.**
9. **Fill the pile as soon as possible after laying.**
10. **Fill with round particle 0.25-0.6mm kiln dried sand. Starting with the sand fill with alternate layers of sand and our 0.8-1.8mm rubber crumb.**
11. **The mix takes 12kilos of rubber and 30 kilos of sand per sq. metre.**
12. **Brush thoroughly after each layer against the direction of the nap to ensure the pile is vertical and finely defibrillated. Leave 15mm above the fill**
13. **During and after filling, brush with hard broom or rotary brush to split the fibres and give a fine, grass like appearance.**
14. **Maintain with regular brushing and top up with a sand/rubber mix as required.**
